

Terms of Use

1. Acceptance of the Terms

These Terms of Use (“Terms”) govern access to and use of the website, the platform, and the content made available by Atlas Trade Academy (“Atlas”, “we”, or the “platform”). By accessing or using our services, the user declares that they have read, understood, and fully accepted these Terms, as well as the Privacy Policy and the Legal Disclaimer.

If the user does not agree with any provision of these Terms, they must refrain from using the website and the services offered.
